- Sept 12, 2013
- 1) Agreements Three: The State (ASF & SLD) Master Agreement; GFFP Public Engagement FY 14 Annual Work Plan (AWP); and The first USFS Supplemental Project Agreement (SPA) for the initial Demo project work.
- 2) Tribal Outreach Continuing to attempting to orchestrate a dialogue with Navajo officials (Dry lake Hills in-holding) – looking toward Ron Lee C-of-S for Rep Kirkpatrick to help facilitate.

## 3) Planning –

- A) USFS The Interdisciplinary Team effort continues: addressing issues raised during Proposed Action (PA) comment period as well as operational items - Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) release early spring.
- **B)** State Completed *Current Condition Report* for all State parcels, as well as 1<sup>st</sup> Year AWP.

## 4) Communication Group –

- A) Public outreach events:
  - 7 completed: Friends of the Rio, Lockett Ranches HOA, DLH field tour, Mormon Lake (ML) area property owners, Democratic Women, Salt River Project, Demo site field visit
  - 6 planned (next two months): ML area field tour, Festival of Science hike, Investment Strategies workshop, Firewise conference, ML property owners field tour, Federal land managers site visit
- B) Water bill insert distributed to all water customers (15,000+).
- C) Brochure completed general info: use in community events, meetings, and other venues
- D) Video shot and being processed Demo project (FWPP website).
- E) Kiosk Placed at DLH trailhead.
- F) Focus Groups Working w/Univ of MT: will be in area to conduct these workshops soon.
- G) Headwaters Economic Institute they are developing a case study on this issue, and plan to use FWPP as the model.

## 6) Monitoring:

- A) Plan Focus on voter questions
  - Spring two large group workshops (25-50 participants) helped frame three key issues:
    - Fire risk/behavior reduction
    - Hydrologic response
    - Socio/economic awareness/support and impact
  - Aug-Nov series of small group focused meetings underway: what monitoring is already planned or underway, are voter questions being answered, where do gaps exist, what needs to be done/funded?
